DESCRIPTION OF BUILDING PRODUCT

Oneshot® screws, supplied by Stanley Black & Decker are intended to be used for fixing polycarbonate roofing sheets to the roofing structure.

The screws are manufactured from hot dipped galvanised (HDG) and have a self-drilling point and a dome washer that ensures the installation is weathertight. The dome washers are manufactured from EPDM. EPDM (ethylene propylene diene monomer) is an M-class rubber that is UV stabilised, has high elasticity, and low carbon content to minimise or eliminate conductivity.

In accordance with NZS 3604:2011, HDG roof fastenings may be used in all interior applications and exterior applications other than exposure zone D. HDG fastenings are not recommended for use with CCA treated timber. EPDM domed roof fixings are provided for in E2/AS1 and E2/AS4.

Within the Oneshot® range there are two types, each of which are supplied with a range in length and thread length.

Type 17 Roofing – One Shot® is suitable for fixing polycarbonate roof sheeting to a timber roof structure.

SDS Roofing - One Shot® is suitable for fixing polycarbonate roof sheeting to steel beams or purlins (roof structure).

Stanley Black & Decker is a member of [AEFEC](#) (Australian Engineered Fasteners & Anchors Council). This is an industry group working together to develop specifications and to certify installers. It also supplies technical guidance based on European and American standards, developments and assessments.

Stanley Black & Decker is a large American company that specialises in the manufacture of tools, hardware security products and fastenings under their wholly owned subsidiaries including DEWALT for fastenings.
