DESCRIPTION OF BUILDING PRODUCT

DeWalt GP50 is a two-component, mix-in-the-nozzle, styrene-free polyester resin system suitable for non-structural applications. It can be used in a standard mastic or professional gun.

The resin and hardener are mixed during dispensing through a static mixing nozzle which is attached to the cartridge. Depending on the temperature of the base material it may cure in as little as 40 minutes.

It is designed to anchor threaded rods to concrete or masonry walls (solid or hollow bricks or blocks). It should not be used for structural applications or where safety-critical long-term sustained load conditions apply.

Stanley Black & Decker is a member of [AEFEC](#) (Australian Engineered Fasteners & Anchors Council). This is an industry group working together to develop specifications and to certify installers, it also supplies technical guidance based on European and American standards, developments and assessments.

Stanley Black & Decker is a large American company that specialises in the manufacture of tools, hardware security products and fastenings under their wholly owned subsidiaries including DeWalt for fastenings.
